WELCOMING MINISTRY

Greeters & Check-In:

Join us in personally greeting everyone on Sunday mornings before service. You can also help answer questions and welcome especially our guests.

Welcoming & Connection

After service, help welcome and follow up with our guests, answering their questions and connecting with them throughout the following weeks.

Hosting Ministry

Arrive on campus early to help set up tables and chairs in our gym/fellowship hall before our 9:20 AM service OR stay a little later to help put away tables and chairs after our 11:20 AM service fellowship time. You may also need to help out at occasional church-wide ministry events.

Kitchen Ministry

Prepare refreshments and coffee for fellowship after each service. Help clean up and put away supplies afterwards.

Parking Ministry

Direct traffic on our campus parking lot before our 9:20 AM service and between our 9:20 AM and 11:20 AM services.

•Camera Operator (Center)

•This position involves operating the camera/tripod. Basic operations involve keeping the preacher in the center of the shot by panning left/right as he walks around stage. All levels of knowledge are welcome; training is provided.

•Camera Operator (Remote)

•This position involves operating the two wall mounted cameras using a controller/joystick. All levels of knowledge are welcome; training is provided.

•Producer

•This person directs the camera team in providing appropriate camera angles and zoom. The producer determines which camera feed is actually shown on the live stream by operating the video switcher. All levels of knowledge are welcome; training is provided.

•Streaming

•This position is in charge of starting/stopping the live-stream broadcast. In addition, this person would monitor and reply to all comments coming into Facebook Live. All levels of knowledge are welcome; training is provided.

Lighting

•This position involves operating the lighting console. Lighting settings are created ahead of time, but this person can also be involved in the lighting design if desired. All levels of knowledge are welcome; training is provided.

Visuals and Lyrics

•Perhaps one of the most important positions in worship, this position mainly involves displaying the lyrics on the big screens during songs using the ProPresenter software. This person provides words for the church to sing! Sermon slides, announcements, and videos would also be displayed throughout the worship service. This person can also be involved in the process of creating the slides if desired.

Sound

•Live Audio

• This position involves operating the sound mixer during worship for the in-person congregation. All levels of knowledge are welcome; training is provided.

•Broadcast Audio

• This position involves mixing the audio for the online stream. All levels of knowledge are welcome; training is provided.

Bible Study Teacher: 7:30-9:30pm Friday Nights

- Lead Inductive Bible Study. For volunteers that are passionate about studying and teaching the Bible, building relationships with students, creating fellowship amongst students. Materials for each semester is given out in advance.
- Teachers are expected to study and teach from the materials given and also differentiate for the grade level as needed. There will be weekly teacher's meeting (30minutes before Bible Study) and email correspondences with the pastors for any questions about the materials.

Family Time Teachers: 9:20am / 11:20am Sunday Service

- Lead Family Time (small group) discussion questions. For volunteers that are passionate about processing sermons, building relationships with students, creating fellowship amongst students.
- Family Time Leaders are expected to be able to lead discussions with discussion questions given from the Sunday sermon for about 25-30 minutes after service. The leaders will also need to take attendance and reach out to students when needed. There will be weekly Family Time Leader's meetings (30minutes before Service) and email correspondences with the pastors for any questions/concerns.
